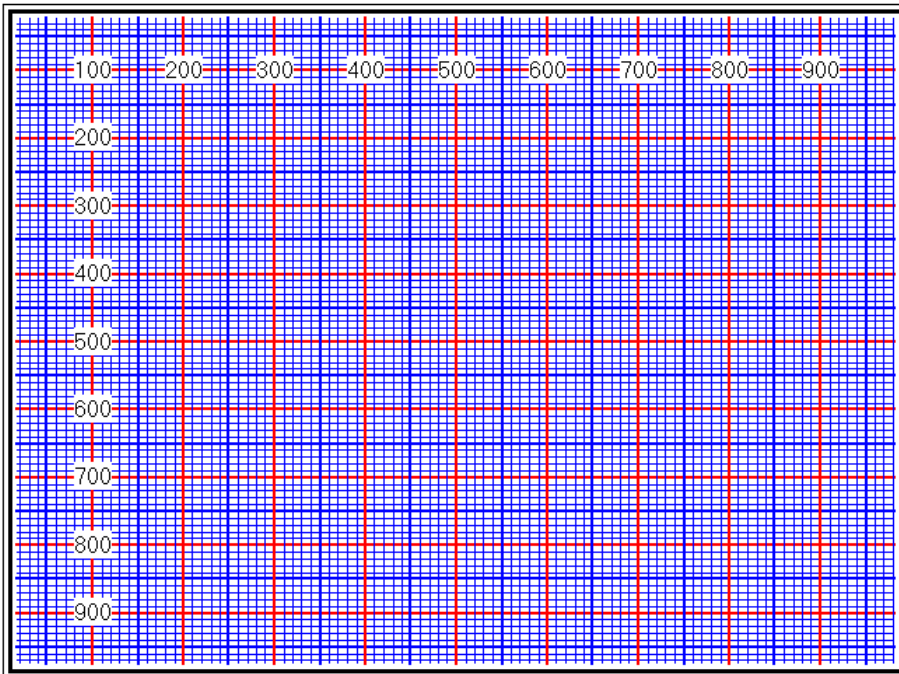


Customizing Pedigrees - Print Pedigree - Modify Style

Setup the page

Print an alignment page for size reference. The visible portion of the pedigree is divided into 1000 parts in each direction. Go to the print pedigree page and click "Print Alignment Page" to print the page for your printer. If the alignment page is not centered on the paper change the page margin values.

Set the margins for the frame around the pedigree. This example has a slightly larger margin on the top of the page as many printers start printing closer to the top of the paper. Adjust as required. Reprint the alignment page to verify your changes.



Clone a style to use for your custom pedigree format. From the "Modify Styles" page click "Clone Style" then move to the description box and enter a new name for the new style.

Page Orientation and the Pedigree "block"



Select Portrait (taller) or Landscape (wider) for the pedigree output.

The pedigree "block" is the portion of the page used for the pedigree data. In this example the pedigree portion starts at 100 or 10% from the top of the page and ends at 900 or 10% from the bottom of the page. These settings only effect the vertical placement of the pedigree data.

Set the location and font for the dog's name



The "Horizontal" value has two functions for the dog's name. If it is a positive number than the Dog's name will appear in the middle of the pedigree block and start at the value. In this case 50 will start the dog's name 5% from the left edge. If the value is negative the dog's name will appear centered on the page. The distance from the top of the page is determined by the absolute value. If -75 is used then the name would be 7.5% down from the top of the page.

Click on the Font box to change the font size, style and font name.

Set the location and font for the other generations

Select the horizontal starting position for each generation. In this example the 5th, 6th and 7th generation values are -1 so they will not be shown. This will produce a four generation pedigree (dog + three generations). The sire and dam will start 17.5% from the left edge. Use smaller values if names go past the right side of the page.

Select the additional data fields to appear with each dog

Line 2 Font

Click in the box to add or clear the additional data fields that will appear on the same line or additional lines for each dog. In this example the Registration number, Date of birth and Call name will be shown below the dog's name. The font name, size and style for the second and third name can be changed by clicking in the appropriate box.

Set the picture location

The picture listed for the dog can appear anywhere on the page. The picture will be sized to fit the space provided. If the space provided does not have the same aspect ratio as the picture it is centered in the space provided. In this example there is a 200 x 200 square for the picture. A tall picture might be scaled to 200 (h) x 160 (w) so the left-hand side would start at 40 and the right-hand side would end at 200. A wide picture might be scaled to 160 (h) x 200 (w) so the top would be at 50 and the bottom at 210.

Set all of the values to 0 if you do not want a picture.

The location of the dog's picture is entered on the "More" page for the dog. If no location is listed no picture will be printed. Pictures can be .jpg files (recommended). GIF pedigrees are not recommended when pictures are used.

Add text to the pedigree

An unlimited amount of text can be placed on the pedigree. Use the scroll bar on the right to see all of the values.

The V and H values determine the text placement. The "Just" value determines the justification of the text.

Some "Text" values have special meanings. "Dog" will use the dog's name. This allows the dog's name to be placed anywhere on the pedigree. If "Dog" appears as a text item this overrides the placement selected above.

Sire and Dam are printed as the words "Sire" and "Dam" but their placement is relative to the placement of the sire and dam's names. This allows the pedigree block to be resized without having to change the placement of the Sire and Dam labels. In the example the word "Sire" will appear 4% of the page to the left of the sire's name.

Some other text values will be replaced with the data for the current dog. These special text values include "DOB", "REG" or "AKC/ID" (registration number), "Owner", "Breeder" and all data field names. If there is a colon (":") after the value the data will be preceded with the field name in (). For example, assuming you have a data field named "Call", a text value of "Call:" will display "(Call)" followed by the dog's call name.

Any other text value will appear as the actual text.

To add an additional line of text move to the last line and hit the down arrow key. The order of the text values is not important.

Click the "Delete Text Line" button to delete unwanted lines.

There is no limit on the number of Styles you can clone and use.
